

## How Do I Download OverDrive Media Console on my PC or Mac?

In order to listen to eAudiobooks on your computer, you will need OverDrive Media Console (OMC).

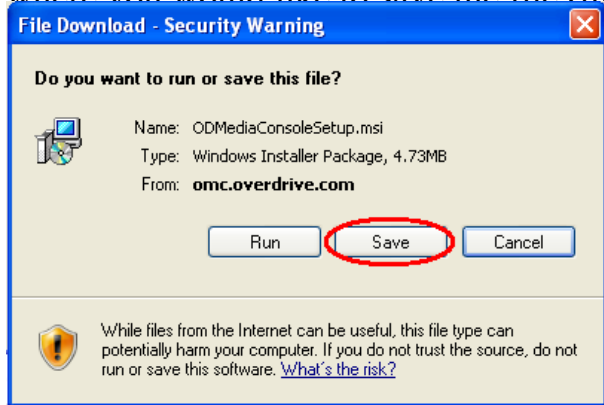
1. Go to <http://www.overdrive.com/software/omc/>. Near the top of the screen, you should see the words “Install OverDrive Media Console on most popular device.” Immediately underneath, you will see a row of links. Click “Mac” or “PC,” depending upon the type of computer you are using.



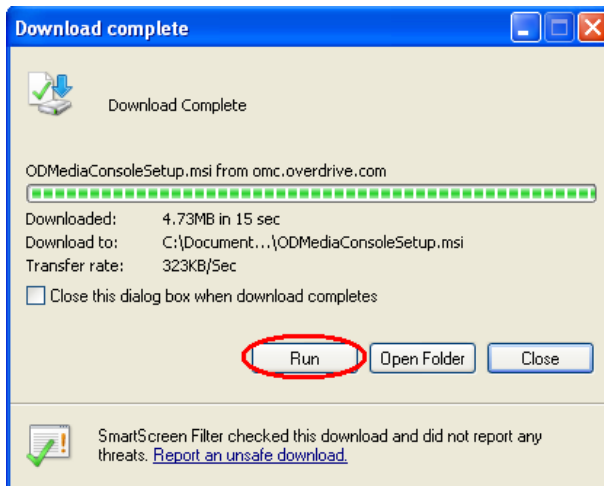
2. Once you have selected “Mac” or “PC,” you will be taken to another page. Click “Download for Mac” or “Download for Windows,” depending upon your computer. (**Please Note:** The screen shots after this step are exclusively for PC/Windows.)



3. A box will appear asking you if you want to “Save” or “Run.” Click “Save,” then choose where you would like to save the file (the Desktop is recommended).



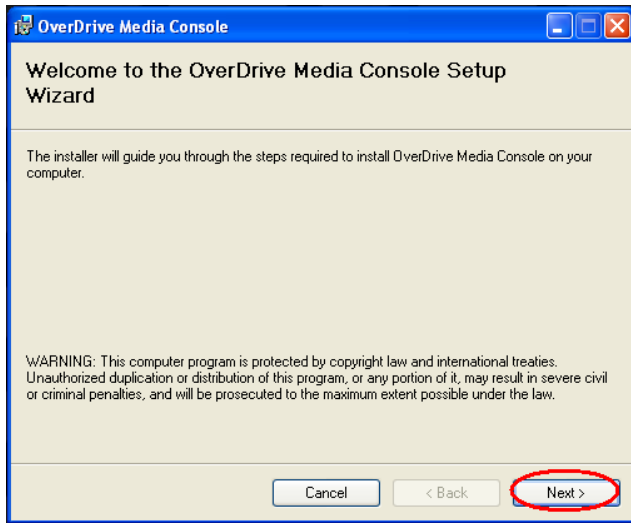
4. Once the file has been saved, another box will appear. Click “Run.”



5. After clicking “Run,” another box may appear. Click “Run.”



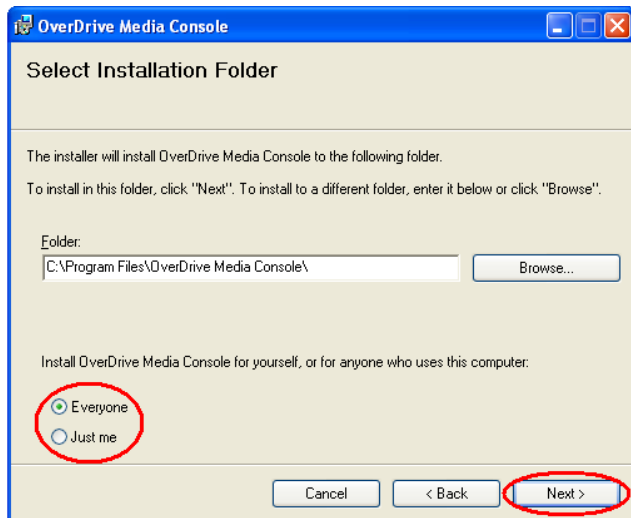
6. Once you have clicked “Run,” another box will appear. Click “Next.”



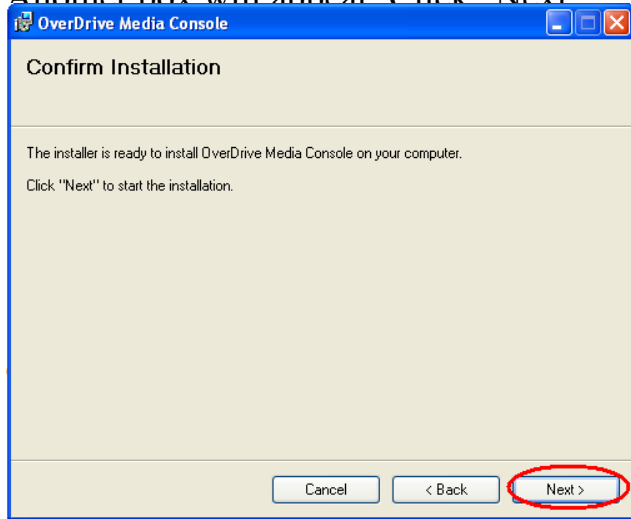
7. Another box will appear. Click the circle next to “I Agree,” and then select “Next.”



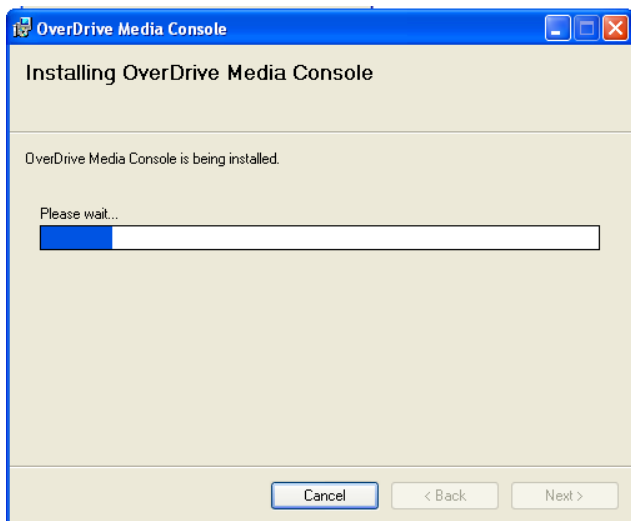
8. The next screen will ask you if you where you want to save OMC and who can use it (it is recommended that you do not change the folder location). Once you have made your choices, click “Next”.



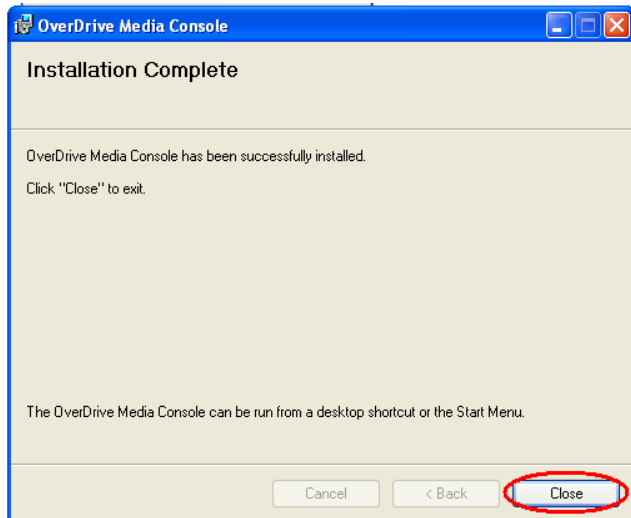
9. Another box will appear. Click “Next”



10. OMC will then be installed on your computer.



11. On the next screen, click “Close”.



12. OMC is now installed on your computer. On PCs, you will see the icon on the desktop. Double-click the icon to open OMC. It should open automatically when you download an eAudiobook. The OMC icon looks like this:



**NOTE: The first time you download an eAudiobook on a PC (this does not apply to Macs), you may need to complete a security upgrade before you can listen to the eAudiobook. To do so:**

Windows Media Player 11 (or newer)...

1. While connected to the Internet, open OverDrive Media Console.
2. Go to *Tools > Windows Media Player Security Upgrade*.  
A dialog box is displayed, notifying you that Windows Media Player requires a security upgrade.
3. Click 'OK'.  
Windows Media Player opens, and the 'Windows Media Player' dialog box is displayed.
4. Click 'Upgrade'.  
Windows Media Player indicates that it is 'Connecting to server...' Once connected, the security component is downloaded and installed. Windows Media Player indicates that the security component was upgraded successfully.
5. Click the 'Close' button in the 'Windows Media Player' dialog box.  
The 'Media Usage Rights Acquisition' dialog box is displayed.
6. Click the 'Play' button.  
Windows Media Player plays a brief file, confirming you have completed the upgrade.

Windows Media Player 9 or 10...

1. While connected to the Internet, open OverDrive Media Console.
2. Go to *Tools > Windows Media Player Security Upgrade*.  
A dialog box is displayed, notifying you that Windows Media Player requires a security upgrade.
3. Click 'OK'.  
Windows Media Player opens, and the 'Windows Media Player' dialog box is displayed.
4. Click 'Yes' to perform the upgrade.  
The 'License Acquisition' dialog box is displayed.

Click the 'Play' button.

Windows Media Player plays a brief file, confirming you have completed the upgrade.
