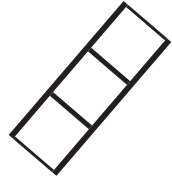


How to Play

Fill in your information on the bottom right corner of the game board.

Each time you read (or are read to) for at least 20 minutes, color or mark off a space on the game board, starting from the empty box of crayons in the top left corner.



Each time you reach a colored circle, you earn a free prize! Show us your game board the next time you visit the Library to pick up your prize.



When you arrive at the final circle, you've completed the game board! Visit the Library to pick up your 4th prize.
