### Twice As Hard: The Stories of Black Women who Fought to Become Physicians

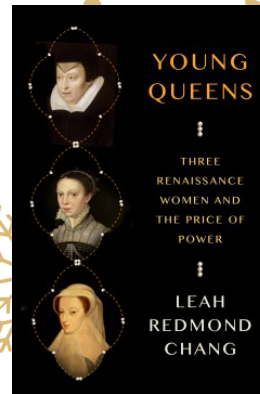

This inspiring biography by a debut author explores the stories of nine Black women physicians whose pioneering e orts and achievements in medicine entailed overcoming immense societal barriers.



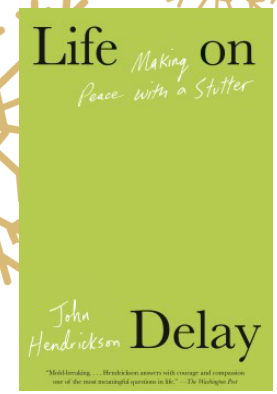
