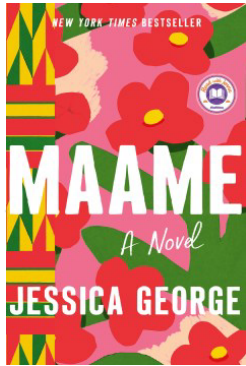

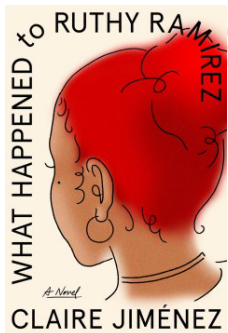
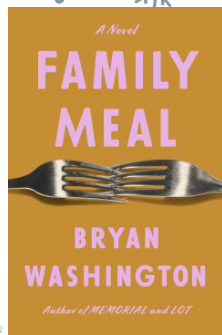

**What Happened to Ruthy Ramirez**

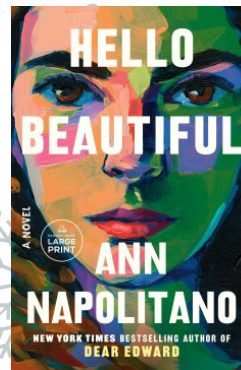
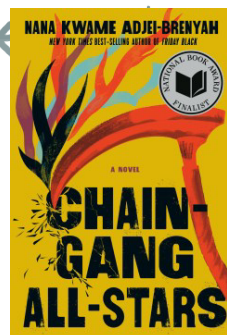

**Chain-Gang All-Stars**

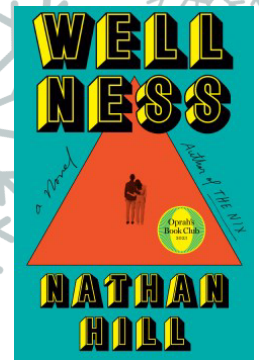

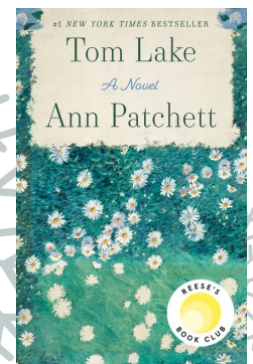

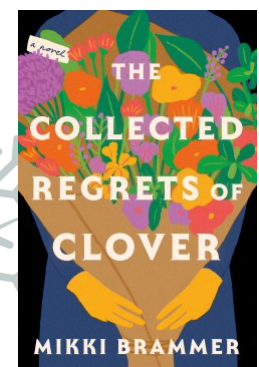
