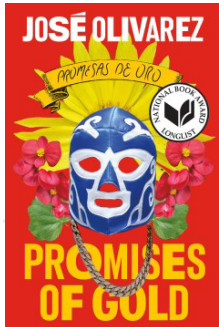

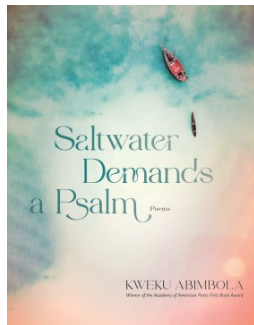
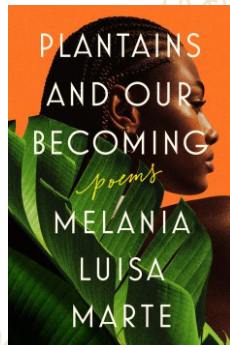


### **Promises of Gold** by José Olivarez

Embrace your next adventure with poems that empower you to see the world around you and recognize valuable lessons from nature.



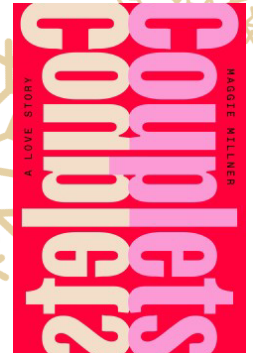
