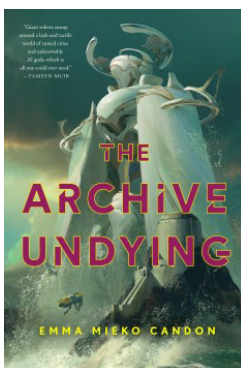

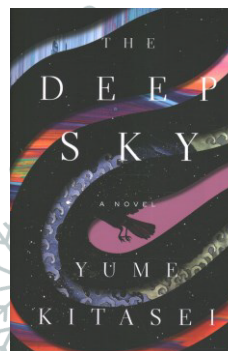
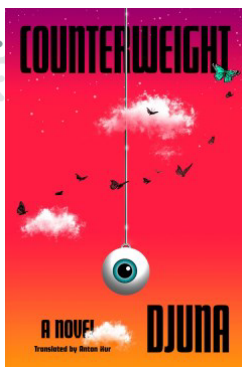

Counterweight

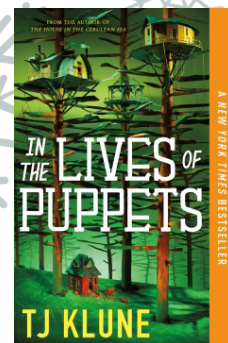

A low-level employee obsessed with his South Korean megacorporation's deceased president's space elevator project draws attention from corporate security as his knowledge poses dangers to the project.



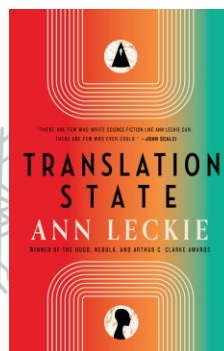

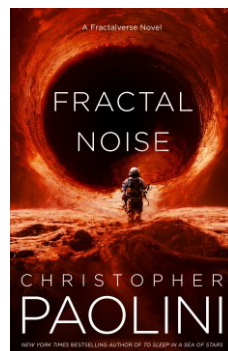

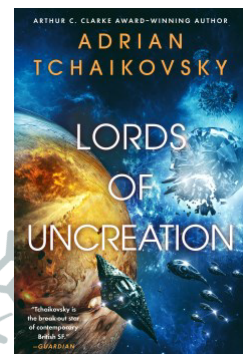
